

GROUP TOUR & TASTING

Dear Wine Lover, Thank you for your interest in bringing your group to Priam Vineyards.

Our Guided tour consists of:

- An explanation of the grape growing and wine-making process as pertains to our unique viticultural district as your group tours the vineyard (weather permitting),
- A question and answer period.
- Return to the tasting room to sample our present wine selection.
- LEVEL ONE TASTING, 1/2 oz each of 4 wines, plus our 11oz. signature wine glass for each in your group.

Our Guided Tour and Tasting policy are as follows:

- Guided Tour & Tasting reservations are available on the days the **winery is open to the public**, <u>Jan.-April:</u> Fri., Sat., Sun.; 11 am to 1 pm. <u>May-December:</u> Weds. through Sun. Weds. & Thurs. 11 am-4 pm, Fri., Sat., Sun.; 11 am to 1 pm., for a **fee of \$18.00 per person** (non-refundable/pre-paid).
- Guided Tour & Tasting are available on days that **we are not open to the public**, *Jan.-April:* Mon.- Thurs.; 11am-5pm, *May-December:* Mon., Tues., 11am-5pm, for a **fee of \$23.00 per person**.
- Please call the winery to check availability.
- Most groups take about 1.5 hours to do the tour, tasting and purchase wine, depending on the size of the group.
- A non-refundable/pre-paid deposit is required.
- Most groups take about 30 minutes to 1 hour to do the tasting and purchase wine, depending on the size of the group and the level of tasting.
- Group Tour & Tasting reservations are required for a minimum of 8 people, the maximum is 20 people at once in the tasting room during normal working hours. Groups larger than 20 will be accommodated in numbers of 20 at a time. Allow approximately 20-30 minutes for your wine tasting.
- No additional members can be added to your group without notice to Priam Vineyards at least 24 hours prior to your reserved time.
- If you wish to bring a group of less than 8 for a guided tour, there is a \$144.00 minimum charge.
- A 22% gratuity is added to all groups. Other fees may apply, contact the winery to discuss the needs of your large group and how we can best accommodate them.
- NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED to be brought into the tasting room at any time.
 Any catering for groups must be arranged through the winery and set up outside of the tasting room, or inside if renting the interior space. Additional site fees apply to catered large group events.
- **Groups of more than 8 require a reservation & fee to picnic in the vineyard.** The Winery Patio cannot be reserved for groups on the weekends, Friday through Sunday.
- We reserve the right to refuse to serve your group if anyone in the group appears to be intoxicated.
- We do not accept group reservations of 8 or more past 2:00p.m.
- All groups must arrive promptly at the scheduled time. Lateness (more than 30 minutes) will result in the
 cancellation of the tasting as well as forfeiture of the prepayment. There will be no refund for "dropouts "or "no
 shows".
- TO RESERVE- Please return the reservation form to Priam Vineyards with credit card information to social@priamvineyards.com. A deposit of \$100 is required to hold a reservation, refundable up to one week prior to reserved date. The reservation form is required three weeks in advance to schedule on our calendar and the full payment for your group is due one week prior to the date reserved and will be charged to your account.

Established in 1998, Priam Vineyards is located in the historic town of Colchester, just minutes from Mohegan Sun Casino, Moodus Resort area, The Goodspeed Opera House, and a number of state parks.

Their international award-winning wines are produced in the style of Northern France and Germany.

Priam Vineyards

11 Shailor Hill Road, Colchester, CT 06415

I-84 past Hartford to RT 2 East, toward Norwich. to EXIT 16, Westchester Rt 149. At the end of the ramp make a right onto RT 149 going South, about 1.5 miles, passing over the Salmon River. Coming up on your right as you're going up the hill will be the Sugar Plum Gift Shop and Christmas Tree Farm. Just past that you will see a sign for "CT Wine Trail", follow the arrow making a right onto Shailor Hill Road. The first driveway on the left (about 200 feet from RT 149) will be 11 Shailor Hill. You'll see a large barn (the winery), and a sign for the vineyard.
